

Induction Assignment for Year 12 Product Design

The first practical project in year 12 will be based around Art Deco and involve pewter casting. For this, you will be set the task to design and make a piece of jewellery based on the Art Deco movement and work.

The Assignment

Over the summer break, you must research the Art Deco movement using Primary and Secondary research techniques.

Primary research- visit museums and get the postcards of Art Deco products. Have a look at any Art Deco Buildings. The Cinema in Letchworth and the Odyssey cinema in St. Albans.

Secondary research- Use the internet, books and library's.

Produce two pages of pictures of Art Deco Artefacts (buildings, furniture, art and graphic illustrations)

Consider what the principals of Art Deco are. Then use annotations to analysis the products you have found and justify how the products show these principals.

Success criteria

Two sheets of work showing Art Deco products. Using both:-

Advanced- primary research, using museums and site visits, documented and well analysed.

Secondary research used to back up the primary and done using the internet and books.
